We have so many beautiful opportunities to minister to our children and the people who care for them as the needs have changed during this unusual season.

Children in unsafe homes – are very vulnerable in this time of quarantine. Children who were being cared for by a 'well-wisher' as we call them – someone willing to step in and help a child in need, have been unable to continue to do this for fear if something bad may happen to the child they were caring for, virus/death, and they would be held responsible.



We have a sibling group of four children in Limuru, another sibling group of three, two young girls and several individual children in Webuye, who had been in the care of people other than their parent(s). During the pandemic quarantine these children had to be taken back to the parent(s) who range in description from abusive drunkard/brewer, mentally unstable, insane, demonic & involved in witchcraft, abusive lying drunkard mother,

unable to support/feed the child, unable to care for children... These are the reasons why we do what we do and why Miracle House exists. Our children need us!

As the days developed into weeks with children being moved back to parents – just like here, homes became even more

unsafe. Our staff members are going to homes, checking on the children, coaching and counseling both parents and as well as guardians, who are extended family members. Also, quite common for multi-generational families and additional family members to live in one household.



Our staff members are incredible, they have risen to the occasion, traveled, prayed, fasted, coached, and counseled to bring hope and healing to our children and to these families and their households.
